Women on Mission

We have heard many reports of the good and the bad regarding the 2024 Olympics in Paris. But we have not heard the God reports. When Covid ended one location, Jason Harris heard the call to "Go to the Nations" according to our Mosaic mag. He learned there was a great need for IMB personnel to go to Paris, France. French people are one of the largest unreached people groups in the world. Large pockets in France of 200-300 thousand people have no evangelical churches at all. Christianity confronts a hostile spiritual climate where those encountered were often uninterested and even resistant to the gospel of Jesus Christ. "We're often asked why we're in France, a western country that maybe doesn't seem like a mission field to some, but the worldview that France unveiled before the entire globe at the opening ceremonies of the Olympic Games is a very clear answer to why we're here," Harris said. International Mission Board's Paris team, explaining their strategy for gospel outreach during the 2024 Summer Olympic Games includes facilitating and mobilizing more than 300 short-term volunteers to hit the streets of Paris sharing the gospel.

Each week of Olympics outreach, volunteers are focused on sharing the gospel using several creative strategies as entry points for evangelism and have invited local French churches to work alongside them and several local pastors have expressed how encouraged they've been.

IMB's Paris team will facilitate and mobilize hundreds of people to hit the streets and share Christ using creative strategies. Harris added, "We had interactions with around 5,400 people in various projects including spiritual surveys, passing out balloons to children, five-minute English, distributing New Testaments and Olympic pin trading." The team also hosted outreach events in partnership with local French churches, including an evangelistic film showing, a children's festival, a talent show and a pick-up volleyball tournament.

IMB's digital engagement team has designed three Olympic pins to use as evangelism tools at the Olympics and Paralympics this summer and using a digital engagement strategy that will extend on-the-ground evangelism and online social media ads, that will run both in Paris and around the world.

Overall, the team counted 396 gospel shares, 500 Scripture portions – a copy of the New Testament or the gospel of John – distributed, 10 digital engagement contacts made, 200 Olympic pins distributed and used to share the gospel and five professions of faith. They also saw nearly 75 people step into a church building for the first time. Ultimately, the harvest is in God's hands. They have already witnessed God drawing people to Himself through volunteer efforts this summer. Pray for the reaping of the harvest.
